  - (b) Describe FOUR uses of electronic systems in the sourcing process. (16 marks)
- Q3 (a) Describe FOUR alternative structures for the procurement function in an organisation. (16 marks)
  - (b) Outline **THREE** areas in which organisational policies could affect the procurement function. (9 marks)
- Q4 Discuss **FIVE** ways in which the objective of profitability, in a private sector organisation, might impact on its procurement activities. (25 marks)
